**THE ASSOCIATION**

The Association of Provincial Bursars is an unincorporated association and was established in 1982.

The objects of the Association are:

1. To facilitate co-operation, collaboration and communication between the members of the Association on matters of mutual interest.
2. To deepen the understanding of members, and other interested persons, in the theoretical and practical aspects of the stewardship of temporal goods by, and within, religious orders and the compliance of religious orders with their obligations under UK law and relevant ecclesiastical law.

To further the objects of the Association, APB shall organise meetings and seminars on the spiritual and temporal aspects of the members' ministries and provide and disseminate information to members to enable them to better fulfil their stewardship. APB itself shall not offer advice but shall help members to find appropriate sources of help.

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**MEMBERSHIP**

**The membership year runs from 1 January to 31 December.**

**All applications for membership are subject to approval by the Executive Committee.**

Membership of the Association (i.e. 'Full' membership) is open to persons who are appointed, employed or contracted by a religious order operating within the United Kingdom to have significant responsibility for the financial stewardship of that order.

One person from any one religious order will be the full member of APB (usually the Bursar). Associate Membership of the Association is open to other persons involved in the financial stewardship of a religious order. There is no limit to the number of persons from any one religious order who may have associate membership.
